
The Township of Scugog, in partnership with Kawartha Conservation and the Scugog Lake Stewards, initiated a project in 2016 to address the shallow water in the Port Perry Bay of Lake Scugog and the Municipal Boat Launch. The build-up of nutrients in the lake due to stormwater runoff has increased the growth of lake plants and algae. The plants and algae die and then settle to the bottom and breakdown every year creating a thick mud layer that decreases the depth of the lake and contributes to the water quality issue in the lake.

In response to this on-going problem, various options of addressing it were considered and presented at the October 25, 2016 Public Information Centre. Since that time, additional studies have been carried out and further agency consultation has been held. The following enhancements are being recommended to improve the situation:

- Create a four acre engineered wetland to filter unwanted contaminants in runoff
- Construct a berm (with walking trail) from Palmer Park Beach to Vos' Independent Grocer to contain and create the wetland
- Dredge 11 acres of the Port Perry Bay including the Municipal Boat Launch to deepen the lake and remove invasive plant and algae

This project is being conducted in accordance with Schedule B of the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (October 2000, amended 2007, 2011 and 2015).
