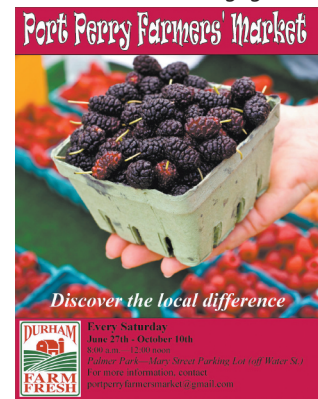

John Street, Wilbur Avenue and Shanly Street - and -Perry Street and Queen Street

The Township of Scugog has recently awarded a contract to Ron Robinson Limited for the reconstruction of John Street, Wilbur Avenue and Shanly Street from Scugog Street (Highway 7A) to Queen Street. The contract also includes the construction of corner "bump-outs" at the intersection of Perry Street and Queen Street.

Leaf & Yard Waste

Residents of Brock, Scugog and Uxbridge have the opportunity to deliver their curbside leaf and yard waste to the local transfer stations in Port Perry (1623 Reach St.) and Brock Township (Sideroad 17) free of charge for disposal during normal hours Tuesday to Saturday from 8 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

Transfer Station delivery requirements for waived leaf and yard waste disposal fees:

- Leaf and yard waste must be delivered in kraft paper bags.
- Brush (up to three tied bundles only) must be delivered no longer than three feet in length and thirty inches in width.
- Only loads consisting of 100 percent leaf and yard waste will be accepted free of charge.
- If leaf and yard waste is delivered as a mixed load, then disposal fees will apply.
