Inclusion on the Township of Scugog's Heritage Registry provides interim protection for sites undergoing change by require landowners to provide the Township with at least 60 days notice of their intention to demolish or remove a building or structure on the property. This notice period allows the Township to make a well informed decision about whether long term protection of the property should be sought through a formal designation process. The Scugog Heritage and Museum Advisory Committee may make a recommendation to Council to designate the property. If Council proceeds with designating the property, the owner can appeal Council's decision to the Conservation Review Board.
