



Notice of Construction Major Street Reconstruction April 2021

The Township of Scugog has contracted Hard-Co Construction to reconstruct Major Street between Earl Cuddie Boulevard and Union Avenue. Improvements to the intersections at Earl Cuddie Boulevard and Union Avenue are included in the works. Work will begin at the end of April and is expected to be completed by the end of August, weather permitting. The work will include removal of the existing infrastructure and the installation of new curb, asphalt, water main, service connections, storm sewer, and sidewalks followed by seeding/sodding, and general boulevard restorations. Driveways aprons will be reinstated in kind upon completion of the project.

During the construction period, the road will be restricted to one lane of traffic. Access will be maintained to residences throughout construction with minor interruptions as equipment and processes pass your frontage. Please exercise caution around the construction site.

A Temporary Water Service system will be installed prior to the existing water main being decommissioned to minimize disruption to your water service. Region of Durham staff will be chlorinating and testing the water to ensure it is potable and meets all applicable codes and standards. The temporary water service will be laid on the ground surface and the Contractor will take precautions to protect the pipe. This temporary water service is normally connected to your existing outdoor water tap or at the existing curb stop.

Project updates, traffic routes, and other pertinent information will be posted on the Township's website under *Township Office, Current Projects, Road Construction Projects* and *Live and Play, Traffic Watch Map*. Additionally, you may wish to follow our social media accounts and My Scugog (myscugog.ca) for additional updates.

Waste collection will be maintained on your regular day. Arrangements for mail delivery, etc. will be made as needed. If you require special accessibility needs please contact the Township with your request. If you require any special access to your home for large vehicles/trailers that may affect construction or have any other questions relating to the construction activities, please contact:
