#### Notice of Construction and Road Closure- McLaughlin Road Culvert Replacement

During the construction period, McLaughlin Road will be closed

between Jobb Road and McLaughlin Road with no thru traffic. Access will be maintained to residences within this zone throughout construction with access only available from the north or south depending on your property location relative to the closure. Southbound traffic on McLaughlin Road will be detoured onto Jobb Road to Regional Road 57 for the extent of the project. ## COVID 19 - Municipal Update

### Scugog Recreation Programs Impacted and Updated COVID-19 Guidelines in place as Durham Region Health Moves to Yellow-Protect Level

Effective: Tuesday, November 10, 2020

Following the Province of Ontario's order to move Durham Region to the Yellow – Protect level on November 7, 2020, the Township of Scugog will be supporting the government's efforts to curtail

the spread of COVID-19 by taking the following actions:

- No person may enter the Scugog Community Recreation Centre without a reservation. All individual program participants will need to register online including skate programs, walking program and the Lookout youth centre.
- Increased spacing between patrons to 3 metres for areas of sport or recreation where there are exercise/fitness classes.
- Fitness classes limited to 10 people per room.
- Pickleball will open back up to 12 participants using 3 courts and will be open to residents of Durham Region only.
