#### Lookout Youth Centre Open with New Guidelines

The Lookout is Scugog's free, supervised youth drop-in space. It is located on the upper floor of the Scugog Community Recreation Centre (1655 Reach St., Port Perry).

New Guidelines are in place to protect the safety of all staff and visitors:

- Masks must be worn at all times in the youth centre.
- Occupancy capacity is 10, if the capacity is reached, youth participants may be asked to leave after a period of 2 hours.
- Youth are responsible for using disinfectant wipes provided after the use of equipment, with the exception of electronics. Staff will disinfect electronics after use.

- No food or beverage is permitted.

Fall 2020 Hours of Operation: Starting September 22, 2020. Lookout is Open: Tuesday to Friday: 4:00 to 8:00 p.m. & Saturday: 1:00 to 6:00 p.m. The Lookout will be closed on October 9 & 10, 2020.

### COVID-19 Municipal Update

#### Ontario Limits Numbers at Unmonitored and Private Social Events

The Province is responding to increasing case numbers of COVID-19 by limiting the number of people permitted at unmonitored and private social events. The new limits for these unmonitored and private social events are 10 people at an indoor events or gathering; or 25 people at an outdoor event or gathering. These new limits do not apply to staffed businesses and facilities. Visit [scugog.ca/covid19](http://scugog.ca/covid19) for details.

#### Stage 3 Reopening of Municipal Facilities and Modified Programs

The Township of Scugog continues to take a cautious approach to reopening its amenities and services to protect staff and public health.

- Residents and users are reminded that all playground and fitness equipment within the Township will not be sanitized.

- Public washroom buildings will also remain closed and portable washrooms will remain available.

#### Scugog Community Recreation Centre & Community Halls

Through Ontario's framework to reopening the Province, guidelines have been expanded to include reopening of additional recreation facilities and amenities. Scugog will reopen the Scugog Community Recreation Centre (1655 Reach St., Port Perry) for some recreation programming and ice sports. Anticipated reopening date of the Scugog Community Recreation Centre is September 28, 2020. Fall recreation programs registration are available with online registration at [scugog.ca/recreation](http://scugog.ca/recreation).

Community halls around Scugog will also be permitted to open. All user groups and any renters will need to submit a return to play/ return to use plan, to Scugog staff, outlining the health and safety measures and protocols that will be in place. The return to play/ return to use plan will then be reviewed by appropriate management and if approved, a contract can be processed.
