**Ontario Limits Numbers at Unmonitored and Private Social Events**  
The Province is responding to increasing case numbers of COVID-19

by limiting the number of people permitted at unmonitored and private social events. The new limits for these unmonitored and private social events are 10 people at an indoor events or gathering; or 25 people at an outdoor event or gathering.
