Notice of Construction and Road Closure-

McLaughlin Road Culvert Replacement

Construction will begin the week of October 26, 2020 and is expected to be completed within 4 weeks, weather permitting.

During the construction period, McLaughlin Road will be closed between Jobb Road and McLaughlin Road with no thru traffic. Access will be maintained to residences within this zone throughout construction with access only available from the north or south depending on your property location relative to the closure. Southbound traffic on McLaughlin Road will be detoured onto Jobb Road to Regional Road 57 for the extent of the project. Visit scugog.ca for complete details including scope of work.

Road Closure– Reach Street

The Regional Municipality of Durham will be repairing the Nonquon River Bridge, which connects Reach Street (Regional Road 8) over the Nonquon River, in the Township of Scugog. Work is expected to begin in late October and includes replacement of the timber bridge deck and asphalt wearing surface. The bridge

will be closed to traffic, with detours in place anticipated for approximately 2-3 weeks while the repair is completed.

The Township of Scugog has received and deemed the following application complete for the purposes of processing:

- Zoning By-law Amendment (Z/11/2020) Application submitted by EcoVue Consulting Service on behalf of M. and P. Passafiume for lands located at 2055 Regional Rd 6/Saintfield Road. This application proposes to rezone the property to permit a winery/cidery and related retail and tasting facility.

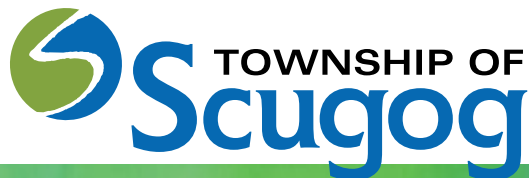
