- Organizing the drawings and plans filing system;
- Assisting with tender preparation;
- Complying with Township of Scugog policies and procedures; and
- Other engineering related duties as assigned.

The successful candidate will:

- Be currently enrolled in Civil Engineering/ Civil Engineering Technology, or related program, at a university or college;
- Be returning to full time post-secondary studies in Fall of 2026;
- Hold a valid Ontario Class G driver's license and have access to a reliable vehicle for business purposes;
