






## **MTO Culvert**

## Lake Ridge Rd (RR 23)





- Myrtle Road to Chalk Lake Road
- Asphalt resurfacing, culvert replacements, \*partial paved shoulders
- Daily lane restrictions during construction
- Current phase complete
- To be completed by September



## Road Construction



\$845,000

#### **Devitts Road**

- Cartwright East ¼ Line to Manvers Scugog Townline Road
- Rural Rehab pulverizing, base stabilization, additional granular, grading, double surface treatment
- □ Total length ~ 3.6 km
- Double surface treatment completed June 5<sup>th</sup>

### **Balsam Street**

- Old Simcoe Road to Rosa Street
- Full depth reconstruction
- Currently under construction
- Expected to be completed in August

#### McKee Road Hill Rehabilitation

- Work includes pulverization of existing surface, drainage improvements, paving, and shoulder stabilization
- Construction to commence after Canada Day long weekend and be completed by end of July

- Work in July and August
- □ Total length ~ 25.7 km
- □ ~ 150 mm thick
- Includes dust control

#### Preventative Maintenance



- Ashburn Road from Townline Rd to High Point Rd
- Single Surface Treatment pavement preservation
- Total length ~ 3.1 km
- Single surface treatment complete
- Slurry seal in August or September

# Second Access to Scugog Island

\$290,000


- Class Environmental Assessment (EA) completed in 2007
- Preferred solution includes two new road links to create a secondary access
- EA Addendum to ensure the project and mitigation measures are still valid
- Links are being refined to minimize excess fill and impacts to agricultural operations
- Online Public Information Centre completed in 2022
- Working to address public comments
- □ EA Addendum anticipated fall 2023
- Earliest construction is 2024

- Union Avenue Reconstruction complete construction in 2024
- Water Street Rehabilitation complete construction in 2024
- Queen Street Rehabilitation Simcoe Street to Water Street
- Perry Street Reconstruction Queen Street to Mary Street
- Old Simcoe Road King Street to Jeffrey Street
- Old Simcoe Road Reach Street to Edinborough Avenue
- Apple Valley Subdivision Rehabilitation
- □ River Street Rehabilitation Bridge North to Simcoe Street
- Water Street OGS Baagwating Outlet
- □ Bridge No. 11 (Cadmus) Replacement

#### Pedestrian Crossovers

- Pedestrian signals Hwy 7/12 and Cragg Road, Greenbank
- Pedestrian crossover Old Simcoe
   Road and Doctor Archer Drive, Port
   Perry
- Pedestrian crossover Simcoe
   Street and Paxton Street, Port Perry
- All installed and operating





## 2023 Sidewalk Replacements/ Infill

- Annual replacement of existing sidewalks and infill sections
- Construction awarded and scheduled for summer





\$200,000

#### Old Rail Lane Trail

- Partnership with Kawartha Conservation
- Permeable pavement trail
- Currently reviewing bids
- Start in summer 2023
- Complete by fall 2023
- Existing invasive Norway
   Maples to be replaced with native plantings in fall 2023 or spring 2024



## Palmer Park Playground

#### Project includes:

- Replacement of playground with rubber play surface, new play structures, zipline, swings and spinning climber
- New concrete curb, seat wall and paved trail
- Drainage improvements
- Construction completed

## Roy E. Carter Playground

- Project includes new playground, new engineered wood fibre surface
- Construction in Fall 2023





## Joe Fowler Picnic Shelter Replacement

- Successful in obtaining \$100,000 grant (Federal and Provincial) towards project
- Existing shelter removed this month
- Construction underway with work to be completed by fall of 2023



## Joe Fowler Tennis Court


Work being coordinated with Tennis Club and is dependent on the outcome of their other planned work and grant application outcomes

## Delpark Park Design

- Concept plan as shown
  - 2.5 acres
  - Spray pad
  - Junior and senior playgrounds
  - Swings
  - Basketball courts
  - Seating area
  - New trees
- Request for Proposals to be issued in summer 2023
- Will include public consultation
- Construction dependent on developers timing, expected in 2024





## Palmer Park Splashpad

\$40,000

- Preliminary concept designs underway
- Servicing coordination occurring with washroom project
- Next steps:
  - RFP for splashpad features
  - Plan and conduct a Public Survey
  - Present Preliminary design to Accessibility Committee
  - Present Preliminary design to Council
  - Finalize design
- Construction planned for spring 2024

# Lake Scugog Enhancement Project



- Design and permitting ongoing
- Preferred Solution
  - Constructing a 245 m long berm
  - Dredging a total of 3.43 ha
  - 14,900 m² wetland with a variety of terrestrial and aquatic habitat for turtles
- Environmental Assessment completed
- Estimated cost \$5.8 million, funding gap \$600K
- To be funded through Township of Scugog, MSIFN, Region of Durham, grants and donations
- Oil Grit Separators installed in 2023
- Berm construction proposed to start Fall 2023 – pending funding and permits

- Employment Area SWM Pond Design
- Georgian Woods SWM Pond Rehab Design awarded to CIMA+

- Fabrication underway
- Site plan and servicing works design underway
- □ To be completed Fall 2023





## Blackstock Works Depot Sand Dome Repairs

\$200,000

- Design and tender preparation underway
- Work includes concrete and structural repairs as well as shingle replacement
- Completion by end of 2023



Sand Dome

#### Townhall 1873 Bell Tower

- Construction contract to be posted on Bids & Tenders shortly
- Work expected to be completed in September 2023



#### SCRC Park Lot – Phase 2



- Second phase of parking lot resurfacing
- Scope to be determined dependant on budget
- Scheduled for fall 2023 or spring 2024 depending on scope and facility programming needs


